Dockless Bikes update

- In September 2023 - Cabinet approved to implement scheme (on trial basis). At least 18 months.
- Since then:
 - Engaging with appointed operators (Lime and Forest) to agree parking approach, fleet size etc
 - Lime - up to 1000 x bikes
 - Forest - up to 300 x bikes
 - Finalising Memorandum of Understanding

Dockless Bikes update

- Launch - ASAP (should be February 2024)
- Parking bay locations marked out - initial 25 x marked bays and over 40 x virtual bays
 - Accessed through the respective operator's mobile app
 - Also displayed on Commonplace (Interactive Map)

We are finalising Communications (including update to Commonplace consultation page and Council website - under Streets for People)
