





#### What is the Haringey Climate Forum (HCF)?



Haringey Climate Forum - Memorandum of Understanding Version 9th March 2022

The Haringey Climate Forum is a partnership, where community groups and activists to come together with Haringey Council, Homes for Haringey and other bodies to discuss, lobby and promote action to address the climate and ecological emergencies.

#### IN PARTNERSHIP together our goals are:

ARINGEY

- To reduce the damage from climate change, pollution and loss of biodiversity, whilst maximising 'cobenefits' such as cleaner air, warmer homes, greater training and employment including a just transition to greener jobs and greater social justice, inclusion and engagement.
- To make the maximum contribution towards cutting CO<sub>2</sub> as soon as possible and at least in line with the Climate Change Action Plan target of 2027 for the Council's own activities and 2041 for borough-wide emissions.
- 3. To Improve the biodiversity of Haringey.
- 4. To reduce residual waste.

#### The Haringey Climate Change Action Plan (HCCAP)

Urgency. "In the context of the emergency, to deliver actions urgently, rather than a linear decline" (p4)

Climate Change Action Plan A Route Map for a Zero Carbon Haringey, strengthened the previous Zero Carbon by 2050 plan. It has 51 pages of action plans with objectives, owners, costs etc under these categories:

- Council (C) - Housing (H) - Non-Domestic Buildings and Workplaces (W) - Transport (T) - Energy (E) - Community (COM)




- March 2019 Haringey declared a climate emergency
- May 2019 UK Government declared a Climate Emergency
- March 2021 Haringey published the Climate Action Plan (HCAP)
- 2027 all Council Activities to be zero carbon
- 2041 Borough wide activities 10% of 2005 level.

#### **HCCAP** coverage

#### Zero Carbon

- <u>Means</u> carbon emissions reduced to a minimum, and where emissions do occur, offsetting them. (p45)
- <u>Magnitude</u> In 2005 emissions within the scope of the 40% reduction by 2020 plan were calculated at 1,041.30kt





#### KEY MESSAGES

- Where heat and electricity come from natural resources climate damage is lessened
- Yearly cost to run renewables is MUCH lower than yearly cost to run coal, gas, oil etc
- Gas for heating and oil for driving will be replaced by low carbon energy
- Local heat and electricity can be owned by local people, individuals, businesses and communities
- Electricity and Gas coming into Haringey needs to be from low carbon sources

Local Area Energy Plans (LAEP) are comprehensive plans integrating demand for electricity and heat with sources eg grid upgrades and renewables, The GLA is sponsoring these, including Haringey. They should include communities as stakeholders, but it is not clear whether local 'ears to ground' groups will be part of these. Nor funding available for genuine 'Citizens Assemblies'



#### E3 - - Develop policies to support installation of Decentralised Energy Networks (DENs)

The 2021 Carbon report showed this map as expecting to have heat delivered from the Edmonton incinerator. The Government gave Haringey a grant of £12.63m and a loan of £15.21m for extending the heat network from Edmonton to Broadwater and Wood Green


Recent investigations into the Enfield Council's Heat Network programme show that

- a) Income from connections is unlikely to enable repayment of the loans and
- b) The carbon incurred by building the network will make this a <u>high carbon option</u>



E4 - Develop a programme of technical advice to encourage the adoption of heat pumps

#### Climate Coalition scorecard rated Haringey as 52% and 23rd in league table

#### Haringey scores per sector

- Buildings and Heating 58%
- Transport 43% \*
- Planning and Land Use 68%
- Governance and Finance 31%
- Biodiversity 23%
- Collaboration and Engagement 76%
- Waste Reduction and Food 56%


Emissions from restaurants, takeaways and canal boat have been specifically identified as additional sources of air pollution within Haringey that will be tackled by this Action Plan.

#### What next? How could the Haringey community help?

What Community groups are there to help? Discover and reach out to all the Community groups in Haringey. Note: work with Haringey Climate Forum and En10ergy that also wants to reach them.

Identifying funding - revisit the Zero carbon fund, S106, CIL, Feed In tariff income etc to agree a budget for climate and ecological work. "Zero carbon funds are collected by LPAs and are

ring fenced for carbon reduction projects"



Revisit HCCAP. Many actions were for 2021/2022 How many have been done? How many should be reviewed due to new circumstances? How many new ones should there be?

Learn from criticisms. Have a channel to listen to complaints and unhappiness (including confidential from employees)
